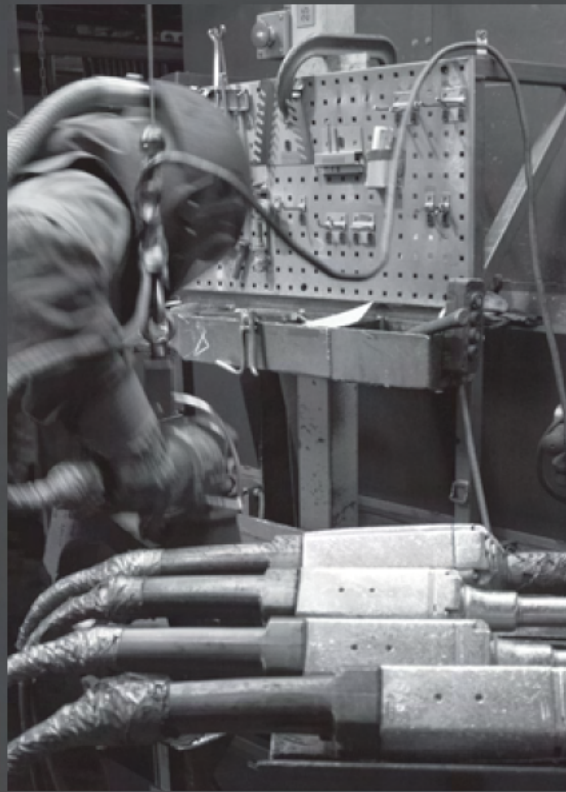

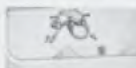

Kohler Legacy

Working toward sustainability is an ongoing journey for Kohler, and creating water-conserving products has been a key component since the 1970s. But to truly have an impact today requires something more – a willingness to take chances, a propensity for innovation and a commitment to making the world a better place. Fortunately, Kohler has a tradition of all three.

The seeds of sustainability were planted in 1913 when Walter Kohler worked with the Olmsted Brothers to develop the first of two 50-year plans for the green spaces of the Kohler Co. campus and the Village of Kohler. Because of these early efforts, the Village of Kohler has been a registered botanical garden since 2004. Kohler has preserved hundreds of acres of wilderness and wetlands as well.

We've grown into a global company. Today our dedication to the environment includes a global sustainability goal of net zero, as well as a strategy to reduce our environmental footprint every year until we reach that goal by 2035. We have a history of looking ahead and doing all we can to ensure the future of our community and our world. We honor that tradition by creating a better future.

Our sustainability goal of a net zero environmental footprint by 2035 requires committed action right now, so we're focusing our efforts in some key areas:



Leadership

To truly have an impact on the global environment, we believe collaborating with organizations and other businesses working toward sustainability is essential. Kohler has taken a leadership role on water-efficiency issues in the industry, working with the United States Green Building Council, the Environmental Protection Agency and other organizations to help change the way we think about water use.



Innovation

Our commitment to conservation is first and foremost a commitment to offering our customers water-saving options that perform beyond expectation. Kohler engineers work tirelessly to develop innovative technologies and designs that improve water-use efficiency. We strive to push the edge of what's possible and discover ideas that move conservation efforts forward.



Water

With four out of ten people in the world affected by water scarcity, water conservation is crucial. Kohler already saves millions of gallons of water annually by reclaiming and reusing rinse water at our faucet manufacturing facility and in our product testing labs. In 2010 alone, we saved more than 200,000 cubic meters of water.



Energy

Kohler has been incorporating energy efficiency and reducing dependence on natural gas since the 1970s when we installed waste-heat recovery systems to capture and reuse pottery kiln exhaust. In 2010, we saved 200 terajoules of energy and reduced greenhouse gas emissions by 18,000 metric tons carbon dioxide equivalents.



Waste

Last year, we reduced landfill use by 7,000 metric tons. Our foundry melts thousands of tons of recycled and recaptured metal every year. Additionally, our cast iron, crafted in Kohler, Wisconsin, is made from mostly recycled material, which cuts down on process waste by making use of it on the front end.



Packaging

In 2007 Americans generated 78 million tons of container and packaging waste. We're committed to helping reduce that number by developing more environmentally friendly packaging solutions, eliminating PVC and reducing our net packaging materials. We redesigned our retail toilet packaging in 2011, achieving a 23% reduction (by weight) in materials used.



Green Building

As a growing global company, our renovation and new building projects are ongoing. Our sustainability goals include incorporating green building principles into all of our facilities. For example, our Environmental, Health & Safety building achieved Silver LEED status and now uses 50% less water with KOHLER® water-saving products.

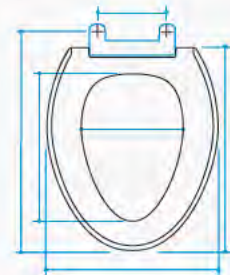
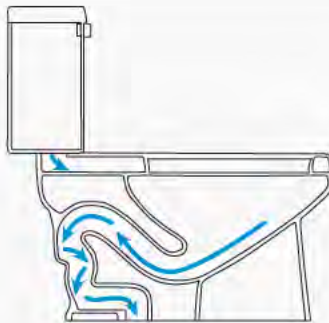
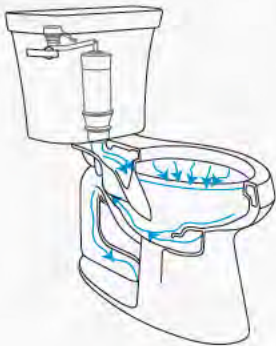
To help ensure our toilets have the power it takes to consistently flush well over what the average person needs and all the toilet tissue your kids can use, Kohler performs a number of highly stringent proprietary bulk removal and plug-resistance tests. In addition, we participate in voluntary third-party testing for Maximum Performance (MaP).

Complete Flush

As part of our balanced approach to performance, we test our toilets against ASME* industry standards, and more important, against our own strict standards for light waste removal. So you can rest assured with every flush.

Clean Bowl Rinse

We've gone beyond the ASME industry code of simply washing away a mark drawn beneath the rim and developed two far more rigorous proprietary tests to verify that our toilets thoroughly rinse the bowl with each flush.



Dynamic Flow Profile

In order to optimize water velocity and flushing power, we study the speed and force of water as it moves through the tank and bowl.

Fully Glazed Trapways

We apply glaze to the trapway – the passageway inside the bowl – of all KOHLER® toilets, creating a smooth surface that ensures a strong, complete flush.

Seat Durability

Our seats go through a series of tests from stain resistance to load bearing and open/close cycle testing to ensure that they stand up to daily wear and tear.

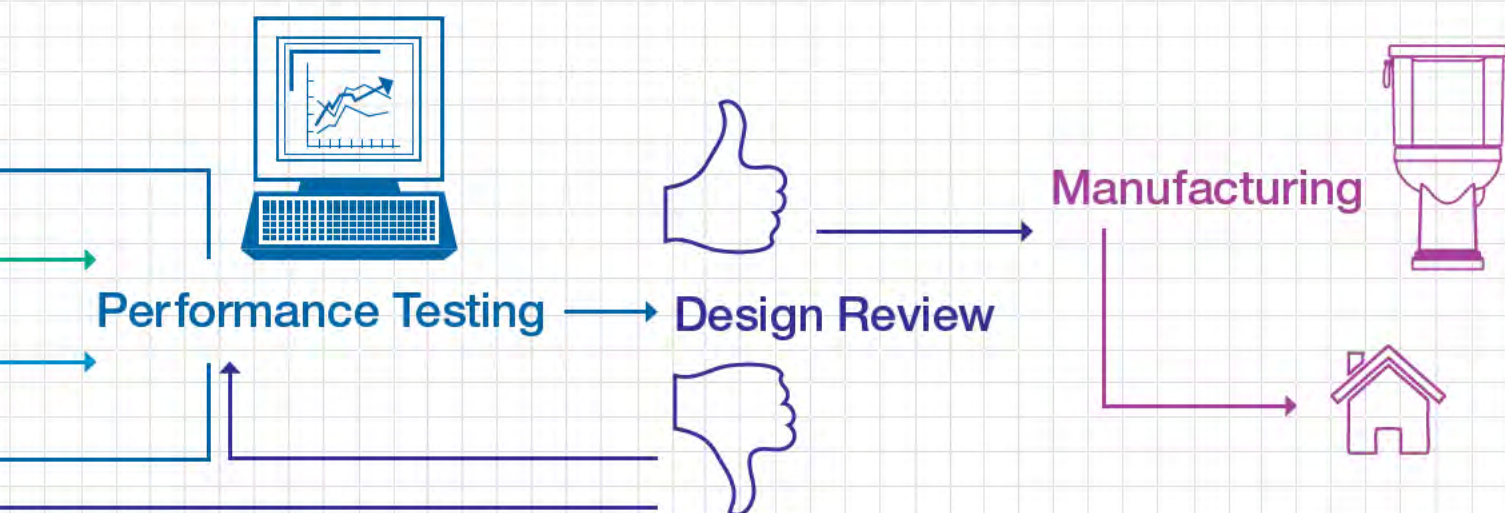

We manufacture our fixtures and faucets in advanced facilities located in 16 countries. Kohler manages every step from concept to end product with the goal of creating award-winning products.

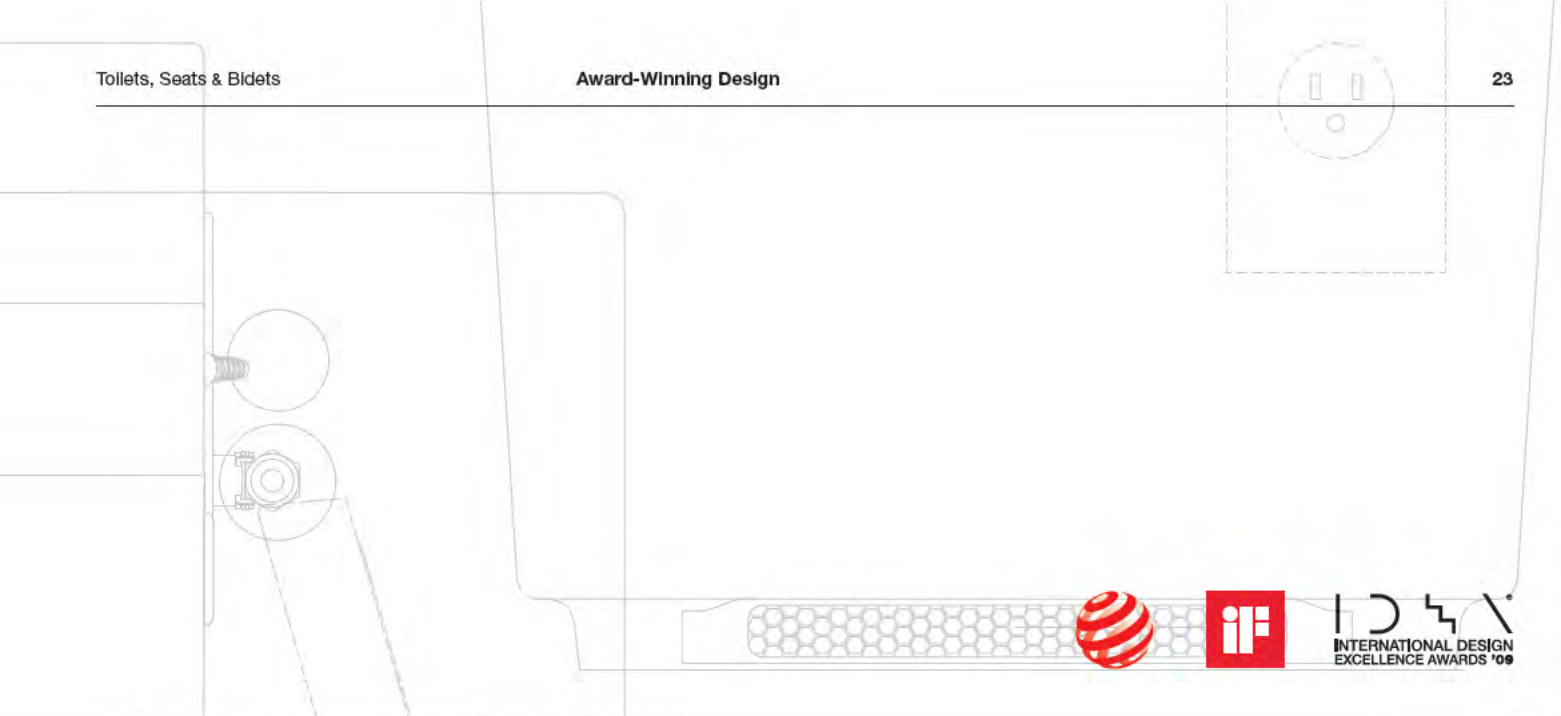

Toilets 101

As you shop for a new toilet, there are a few things you'll want to consider along with style. We've listed the main features and amenities here, but you can also refer to the glossary on pages 84-87 for additional definitions of terms.



One- Vs. Two-Piece

One-piece toilets integrate tank and bowl into a seamless, space-saving design that is easy to clean. Some low-profile models can be installed under a vanity extension when space is at a premium. Because of their special design detail, most one-piece KOHLER® toilets ship with a Quiet-Close™ toilet seat with Quick-Release™ functionality.

Two-piece toilets feature the traditional design of a separate tank and bowl. Two- and three-bolt installation systems provide a sturdy, level connection between the tank and bowl, making installation easy.

Bowl Shape

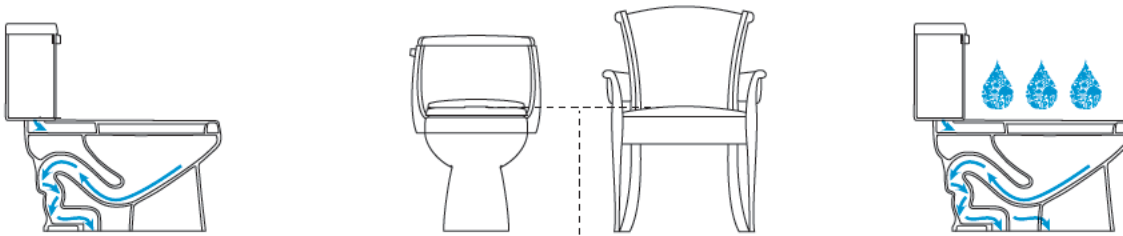
Round-front bowls require less space and are good for small children.

Elongated bowls provide added room and comfort for adults.

Compact elongated one-piece toilet designs enable an elongated bowl to fit in a round-front space.

Concealed & Skirted Trapways

Most toilets have an exposed trapway that's often hard to clean because of its location behind the bowl. Toilets with a concealed trapway feature a smooth surface at the back of the toilet where the trapway would normally be visible. Skirted trapways go a step further and offer a clean line from front to back. Both concealed and skirted trapways simplify cleaning.



Flushing Technology

We offer multiple flushing technologies to meet the needs of different homes and bathrooms – single-flush gravity, dual-flush gravity and assisted-flush. Glossary of Terms

ADA-Compliant Toilets

Toilets will comply with the American with Disabilities Act when installed per the Accessibility Guidelines, Section 604: Water Closets and Toilet Compartments. The Act requires, among other things, installation of an open-front toilet seat that is, at seat top, 17" to 19" inches above the finished floor.

Bowl

A water-containing receptacle that receives liquid and solid body waste; two general bowl classifications are round-front and elongated.

Close-Coupled

A term for a toilet with a separate tank and bowl, secured to each other, and with a separate tank cover. Also referred to as a two-piece toilet.

Cycle Time

The time it takes from the instant a toilet flush lever is actuated until the instant the water supply shuts off, completing the flush cycle.

Elongated Bowl

A toilet bowl having dimensions of about 14" wide by 18½" long (from the center of the seat hinge holes to the front edge of the outside rim).

Bidet

A personal hygiene fixture with hot and cold water supply for genital and perennial cleanliness.

Canister Flush Valve

An extraordinarily powerful flushing technology for single-flush gravity-fed 1.28 and 1.6 gpf toilets. Water enters the valve from 360 degrees, creating a smooth, consistent water flow.

Comfort Height®

The height of a toilet bowl (with seat) that stands at the same height as a standard chair measuring between 17" and 19" for maximum comfort and ease when sitting down or standing up.

DryLock™

This exclusive system saves installation time and helps prevent water leakage. A metal bracket, placed at the bottom of the tank, means that no bolt holes are drilled into the tank, virtually eliminating water leaks. Additionally, the installer can secure the tank to the bowl with only one tool, a socket wrench, without having to reach inside the tank.

Fill Valve

The mechanism that controls the flow of water into a gravity-operated toilet tank. When the toilet is flushed, the float drops and opens the fill valve, allowing water to enter the tank and/or bowl. The float rises as the water level in the tank is restored, and shuts off the fill valve when the tank is completely filled.

Bidet Functionality

A soothing, fresh alternative to toilet tissue, bidet seats and toilets feature a user sensor that triggers an in-tank water heater, while dual wands give a soft, aerated wash in posterior and anterior positions. A touch of the keypad controls rate and temperature of water flow.

Class Five® Technology

A flushing technology designed to create extraordinary flushing performance with an industry-leading 3¼" flush valve. KOHLER® 1.28 and 1.6 gpf toilets with Class Five technology provide powerful water flow to maximize the gravity-fed flush and feature simplified installation.

Concealed Trapway

This feature provides a clean transition at the back of the toilet base, hiding the trapway for aesthetic and cleanability purposes.

Dual-Flush

Dual-flush gravity-fed toilets rely on the force of gravity to achieve a powerful flush, much like single-flush gravity-fed toilets. The primary difference is simply the added choice between a half and full flush.

Flapper

Also known as a flush ball, the flapper is the moving part of the flush valve that seals the water into the tank or allows water to exit the tank for the flush cycle. This is the predominant replacement part used on conventional toilets.

GPF

An abbreviation for “gallons per flush,” a term used when discussing water consumption for toilets.

Gravity-Fed Toilet

A toilet that relies on the natural downward pressure (or “head”) of water in a toilet tank to flush the toilet effectively.

High-Efficiency Toilet

Single- or dual-flush water-saving toilets that use 1.28 gallons of water or less. Installing a high-efficiency toilet can save an average family of four up to 16,500 gallons of water per fixture every year. High-efficiency toilets can carry the WaterSense® logo.

Insuliner® Tank Liner

Insuliner is a registered Kohler trademark for factory-installed tank insulation which minimizes condensation on the outside of the tank (also known as tank sweating) when exposed to high humidity.

One-Piece Toilet

A toilet in which the tank and bowl are manufactured as a single vitreous china fixture. Typically, one-piece toilets have a lower profile than two-piece toilets, with some featuring a Comfort Height® bowl.

Power Lite® Technology

Power Lite technology uses an electric pump to deliver water from the tank through the bowl and trapway. To operate, it requires an electrical outlet near the toilet.

Pressure Lite® Technology

Pressure Lite technology uses the supply line to pressurize a specialized vessel in the tank, providing a strong and reliable flush.

Q2 Advantage™

These toilet seats feature Quick-Attach hardware and Quick-Release functionality for speedy installation and easy cleaning.

Q3 Advantage™

These toilet seats feature Quiet-Close technology, Quick-Release functionality, Quick-Attach hardware and rubber bumpers.

Quick-Attach™ Hardware

Innovative hardware speeds installation and provides a tighter, more secure fit. Available on all Q2 & Q3 Advantage seats.

Quick-Release® Functionality

A KOHLER® technology that unlatches the back hinges of the toilet seat for easy seat removal and convenient cleaning; no tools required. Available on all Q2 & Q3 Advantage seats.

Quiet-Close™ Technology

A KOHLER technology utilized on toilet seats that prevents slamming by slowly bringing the seat to a gentle close. Available on all Q2 & Q3 Advantage seats.

Refill Tube

On most toilets, a refill tube directs water from the fill-valve into the tank and overflow tube to refill the bowl after the siphon break.

Reverse-Trapway Toilet

A water closet having a siphonic trapway at the rear of the bowl, and integral flushing rim and jet. Minimum dimensions are a 9" x 8" water spot and a 1½" ball pass.

Rim Holes

A series of small holes in the underside of a toilet rim around the circumference of the bowl. Incoming water flows down into the bowl through these holes, creating a rinse effect, or “rim wash,” over the entire inner surface of the bowl.

Glossary of Terms

Rough-In Dimensions

The distance from a finished wall or floor to the center of the waste or supply opening or mounting holes on a plumbing fixture. A 12" rough-in is most common.

Round-Front Bowl

A toilet bowl having dimensions of about 14" wide by 16½" long (from the center of the seat hinge holes to the front edge of the outside rim).

Rubber Bumpers

Located on the underside of the seat, rubber bumpers grip the bowl to add stability and help prevent shifting. Available on Q3 Advantage™ seats.

Siphon Break

The point in a toilet flush when air is reintroduced into the trapway, "breaking" the siphonic action. The siphon break is usually heard as a deep gurgling at the conclusion of a flush.

Siphoning

The suction or pulling effect that takes place in the trapway of a toilet as it is filled with outgoing water and waste. An effective siphon is critical to a successful flush for any toilet.

Siphon Jet Toilet

A toilet having a siphonic trapway at the rear of the bowl and integral flushing rim and jet.

Skirted Trapway

Skirted trapways offer a clean line from front to back and are easier to clean than exposed trapways.

Supply Stop

The valve that provides on/off toilet water supply control, typically located in the wall behind the toilet.

Tank

The fixture reservoir for flushing water. On a conventional toilet, the fill valve, flush valve and trip lever are installed in the tank. A tank lid closes the top tank opening.

Trapway

The channel in a toilet that connects the bowl to the waste outlet. The trapway is where siphonic action takes place, and it's measured in terms of the largest diameter ball that can pass through it. Also referred to as "passageway."

Trapway Seal

The height of water in a toilet bowl "at rest," it provides a water seal that prevents sewer gases from entering the home. The trapway seal is measured from the top of the dam to the inlet of the trapway. Also referred to as "deep seal."

Trip Lever

A lever, often a handle, rotated to initiate the toilet flush cycle. Factory-installed trip levers have a Polished Chrome finish; optional trim kits offer trip levers in other finishes. Toilets equipped with a Peacekeeper® seat-actuated flush do not have a trip lever.

Two-Piece Toilet

A toilet with a separate tank and bowl. Also referred to as “close-coupled.”

Vitreous China

A term applied to plumbing fixtures that are comprised of ceramic materials, fired at a high temperature to form a nonporous body with exposed surfaces, and coated with ceramic glaze.

Water Closet

Another term for toilet. A plumbing fixture having a water-containing receptor that receives liquid and solid body waste and, upon actuation (flushing), conveys the waste through a trapway into a gravity drainage system.

Water Spot

The water surface in the toilet bowl once the flush is completed. This is established by the height of the integral trapway dam. Usually expressed in inches of width by length. Also referred to as “water surface”.

Water-Saving Toilet

A classification of toilet that uses no more than 1.6 gallons per flush.
